**TOWNSHIP OF ALEPPO****LEGISLATIVE MEETING MINUTES****June 19, 2023****CALL TO ORDER:**

President George Jones called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and roll call. Those in attendance were Vice President Arthur Williams, Commissioner Dan Darragh, Commissioner Amy Richert, Commissioner Judy Haluka, Solicitor Harlan Stone, Manager Gwen Patterson, and Secretary Patty Krecek. President Jones announced that the meeting is being recorded.

**MINUTES:**

Commissioner Darragh made a motion to approve the June 12, 2023 Workshop Meeting Minutes. Vice President Williams seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR PA HOUSE BILL 589:**

Commissioner Darragh made a motion to send a letter of support for PA House Bill 589 Establishing the Coal and Clay Mine Subsidence and Landslide Insurance and Assistance Program. Vice President Williams seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT WITH CARGILL:**

Commissioner Darragh made a motion to approve the Amendment to the Articles of Agreement with Cargill, Inc. for extension of time to purchase the required allotment of salt for the 2022-2023 Winter Season. Vice President Williams seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**REPORTS:****POLICE:**

Ohio Township Chief Joseph Hanny gave the report for the month of May. There were 60 calls, which included 39 EMS assists, some alarm calls and some animal complaints that were dealt with, and two fraud cases, which had to do with gift cards. Chief Hanny said there is no state, local, or federal government agency that will ask for gift cards by telephone. He said there are many types of scams, so if someone receives a call and they are unsure of what to do, they should hang up the phone and call the police department. Chief Hanny also said they have been doing some on and off traffic posts around the Township. The report was accepted.
