

Quaker Valley Ambulance Authority – Municipal Assessment

The Township pays an annual membership assessment for its residents. This membership assessment covers all Township residents (it is based on population.)

When an ambulance is called, QVAA will bill the resident for the ambulance trip if insurance was not provided at the time of the trip.

If an Aleppo resident gets a bill from QVAA, they should call QVAA to provide their insurance information so that QVAA can bill their insurance.

Insurance will be billed, and 50% of the balance of the bill not covered by the insurance will be covered by the annual membership.

For example:

Ambulance call	\$1,000
Insurance pays	\$500
Membership covers	\$250
Resident responsibility	\$250

There may be differences and/or exceptions depending on the resident's individual insurance coverage, so the resident who received the bill should call the **QVAA billing office at 412-262-2620** to discuss their particular claim.
