**WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES**

**March 13, 2023**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

President George Jones called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and roll call. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dan Darragh, Commissioner Judy Haluka, Solicitor Harlan Stone, Manager Gwen Patterson, and Secretary Patty Krecek. Vice President Arthur Williams and Commissioner Amy Richert were not in attendance. President Jones announced that the meeting is being recorded.

**MINUTES:**

Commissioner Darragh made a motion to approve the February 20, 2023 Legislative Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Haluka seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**PENNDOT MEETING REGARDING TRUCKS ON REDGATE ROAD:**

Manager Patterson said there have been discussions for months about trucks using Redgate Road, and Haysville Borough, which is at the bottom of Redgate Road where it turns into River Road, has said they are unhappy with the number of trucks coming down the hill. She said Haysville contacted PennDOT and requested a site meeting, which will be tomorrow, March 14, 2023. Manager Patterson said she will be attending along with representatives from PennDOT and Ohio Township Police.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**2023 EARTH DAY ROADSIDE CLEANUP EVENT:**

Manager Patterson said that every year there is an Earth Day roadside cleanup event where volunteers and Township staff get together on a Saturday and clean up trash along certain Township roads, roads in Glenfield Borough down by Route 79, and possibly some roads in Sewickley Heights. She said that Earth Day this year will be Saturday, April 22, 2023. She said anyone who is interested in participating should be at the Township building at 9:00 a.m. for coffee and donuts, and then the roadside cleanup will begin. Manager Patterson said she was contacted by Fern Hallow Nature Center, and they offered to participate on parts of Glen Mitchell Road. She said they are working on trying to get that done safely.

**GLENFIELD BOROUGH’S EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT REQUEST:**

Commissioner Haluka said she received a request from one of the Commissioners from Glenfield Borough to be their Emergency Management Coordinator. She said Osborne and Haysville Borough may also be asking her to be their Emergency Management Coordinator. Commissioner Haluka asked the Board of Commissioners if they think it would be a conflict because she is the Emergency Management Coordinator for the Township of Aleppo. She said one way this could be done is to have one Emergency Management Coordinator for a small region and they would share an Emergency Operations Plan. Solicitor Stone said there would not be a conflict; however, he suggests that since she would be acting as an independent contractor, then Aleppo Township would want an agreement with the other municipalities about the shared nature of the services and indemnification also would be included in the agreement. Commissioner Haluka said she would like to meet with the Commissioner from Glenfield Borough and determine what their needs are, and the Board of Commissioners agreed.

**MARCH LEGISLATIVE MEETING - TUESDAY, MARCH 21, 2023:**

President Jones said the March Legislative Meeting will be on Tuesday, March 21, 2023, instead of Monday to accommodate the Sewickley Heights Manor Homeowners’ Association Annual Meeting.
